## Loomis Center Course Descriptions

**Key of Liberty (US founding era history project--leadership style)** Students are challenged, in a fun and inspiring environment, to gain a knowledge of and an admiration for the Constitution of the United States of America and the men and women who made our freedoms possible. They will have the opportunity to improve their reading, writing, and oral presenting skills by earning rewards for the completion of assignments. In addition, students will have the opportunity to learn: early American history; the founding documents of this country; law and government.

**Pyramid Project (math & science project--leadership style)** Students will have the opportunity to learn the philosophy of an holistic approach to math and science through truth, logic and Newtonian math skills.

Students will work out of their current math text, but, in addition, will learn: math and science concepts in their personal/family core book; ideas of many of the great mathematicians and scientists; how to read a math text; and, how to write their own meaningful equations. This is not a typical math class, but rather is taught in the leadership method of understanding math through classics.

**Thomas Jefferson Youth Certification (scholar skills project--leadership style)**

This is a rigorous three-semester leadership course that prepares students to move through a life of scholarly learning with a focus on teaching students how to think. It has been very effective in preparing students for the academic rigors of college life as well as instilling in the youth a love of the classics and need for personal preparation as a leader throughout their life. This course is the crowning jewel in leadership education for pre-college young adults.

**Language Arts & Scholar Prep Course (scholar preparation project--leadership style)**

Students will learn to write well-developed essays based on classics they will study throughout the course of the school year. In addition they will learn how to think beyond the scope of the text and achieve a greater understanding of the principles taught therein.

**Shakespeare (language arts/drama project--leadership style)** In a more relaxed environment of learning, students will explore Shakespeare's works and be introduced to elements of poetry, the Elizabethan Era, mythology, and figurative language. Students will also have the opportunity to study theater through characterization, elements of drama, and stage direction, and will gain valuable life skills through actor and improvisational training.

**World History** This class offers a chronological study of the great times and events in the history of the world. Through a study of original works and biographies, students will travel through history starting with ancient settlements and ending in modern times.
