Call 894-3952 for an appointment. Paradise Center will begin at 1:00 and go until 4:00. Call 872-8294 for an appointment. K, 1st, 2nd, 5th, 7th and 10th graders will have priority for the hearing and vision tests. If space is available other grades will be scheduled. Students in the 5th grade or older have priority for the Scoliosis testing. Girls are encouraged to wear a bathing suit under their clothing for easy assessment of the spine.

- The next **California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE)** opportunity for students to take the test will be February 7 and 8 at both the Paradise and Chico centers. **Passing this test is a requirement for graduation in every school in California.** Prep classes for the CAHSEE are being offered. - The date for the **4th and 7th grade Writing Test** at both the Paradise and Chico centers will be March 7th for the test, make ups will be March 8th for students who are sick the day of the test.

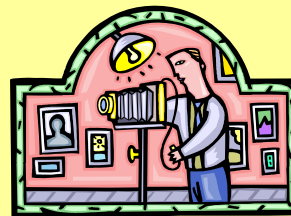

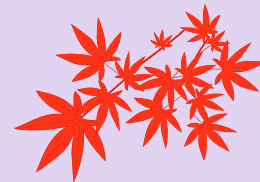
How do I participate ?
